HELL SHIPS:

Japanese Prisoner of War Transports

TATTORI MARU: Departed Manila on Oct. 8, 1942 with 1202 U.S. POWs. En route 14 Americans were transferred to hospital at Takao, Formosa and 585 at Kobe, Japan. Arrived Mukden, Manchuria on Nov. 11. **Eleven dead.**

UMEDA MARU: Departed Manila on Nov. 7, 1942 with 1500 POWs. Arrived Japan on Nov. 25. **Five dead.**

NAGATO MARU: Departed Manila on Nov. 7, 1942 with 1700 POWs. Arrived Japan Nov. 25. **One hundred and fifty seven dead.** (Seven died en route; 150 dying men were left on dock and never seen again.)

TAGA MARU: Departed Manila in Sept. 1942 with 850 POWs aboard. **Seventy dead.**

SHINYO MARU: Departed Zamboanga, Mindanao on Sept. 3, 1944 with 750 POWs. Torpedoed by *USS Paddle* on Sept. 7. **Six hundred and sixty eight dead.**

HARO MARU: Departed Manila Oct. 3, 1944 with 1100 POWs. Arrived Takao, Formosa on Oct. 25. **Total deaths on board were 39** with more lost in the following days from mistreatment and exhaustion.

ARISAN MARU: Departed Manila in Oct. 1944 with 1800 POWs. Torpedoed by *USS SNOOK* on Oct. 24. **Seventeen hundred and ninety five dead.**

(Unknown) MARU: Departed Manila on Oct. 16, 1944 with 1100 POWs. Torpedoed by unknown submarine. **Eleven hundred dead.**

ORYOKI MARU, BRAZIL MARU AND ENURI MARU: **ORYOKI MARU** departed Manila Dec. 13, 1944 with 1800 POWs. Sunk by US Navy carrier planes off Bataan Peninsula on Dec. 15. **BRAZIL MARU** departed Lingayen Gulf on Dec. 27 with survivors. Arrived Jan. 2. **ENURI MARU** departed Takao on Jan. 14 with survivors. Arrived Moji, Japan on Jan. 29. **Fourteen hundred and twenty six dead.**
